Our Sixth Form provides pathways for all students, the large majority of whom go on to university, with the rest securing apprenticeships or employment.

We offer a diverse range of qualifications academic, vocational and occupational. The partnership with our wider Trust gives us access to an unparalleled range of A Level courses and our 'state of the art' Keyworth Centre offers industry recognised occupational courses occupational courses in areas such as motor vehicle maintenance and construction.

Our dedicated team of Sixth Form staff ensure that each student receives the highest standard of support and care. In addition, first class careers and university guidance helps students through every step on their journey toward achieving their aspirations.
